Study trips

EU Study Trips are intensive study visits (12 days) of partners from Russia and Kazakhstan to EU partner institutions, supervising the elaboration of new SAGRIS modules.

4 Study Trips are preliminary planned for Summer 2021 – Spring 2022. Some deviations from the planned schedule is possible depending on the pandemic situation in the world.

1. Study Trip on Module 1 “SMART Agriculture and Digitalisation”
to University Nuertingen-Geislingen, Germany
2. Study Trip on Module 2 “Crop and livestock systems under Climate Change”
to Czech University of Life Sciences, Czech Republic
3. Study Trip on Module 3 “Advanced methods of scientific working”
to Warsaw University of Life Sciences, Poland
4. Study Trip on Module 4 “Transdisciplinary research methods for sustainable agriculture”
to German Institute for Tropical and Subtropical Agriculture, Germany

Purpose of Study Trips are:

- EU input and training of staff (RU & KZ) in module related topics
- Joint elaboration of contents and teaching materials of the respective module
- Module Working Group meeting is a part of each study trip

Who can apply

- ✓ Staff from partner universities involved in development of SAGRIS modules
- ✓ Doctoral Students from partner universities, enrolled at study programmes of respective fields/ performing research on themes, related to SAGRIS modules

Number of candidates to be selected is limited and varies for different modules.

Selection criteria for staff:

- Involvement and commitment into development of the respective module
- Expertise in the specific field/ potential career development*
- Language skills (English proficiency)

Selection criteria for doctoral students:

- Correspondence of doctoral research to the topic of respective study trip/ respective module
- Expertise in the specific field/ potential career development*
- Involvement and commitment into development of the respective module
- Language skills (English proficiency)

*Attention will be paid to involve young colleagues who might be less experienced but are foreseen to continue educational programs/ doctoral students with high potential to continue educational programs at their home university.
