For this, we hopefully expect that scholars, experts, farmers, entrepreneurs, teachers, graduate students, and doctoral students of research and educational institutions, managers and specialists of commercial and non-profit organizations and public associations will take part in this conference. It is expected the performance of world-renowned experts and scholars in the field of organic agriculture.

The conference will be conducted in the following areas:

• the innovative production technology of organic agricultural products;

• the plant protection in ecological sustainability of agrobiocenoses certification and marketing of organic products.

Last but not least, this conference is also thought to provide:

• the exhibition of organic products and auxiliary materials - biopreparations, equipment, books, booklets, etc.;

• visiting the farms producing ecologically clean agricultural products in the region of the food belt of Astana.

At the conclusion of the conference the proceedings of the conference will be published. The most interesting articles will be also included into a special issue of the journal "Science Herald of S.

Seifullin KATU" (it is on the list of publications, recommended by the Committee for control of education and science of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan), dedicated to the development of organic farming in Kazakhstan.

- 1) The registration deadline to participate in the conference is 20 May 2016 (application form according to Appendix 1).
- 2) The deadline for submission of abstracts (according to Appendix 2) to be included in the proceedings is 3 June 2016.
- 3) The conference will start on 30 June 2016.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS (ABSTRACTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS):**

• The abstract has to be written in English.

• The abstract, including a list of references, must not be longer than 4 pages of A4 format (portrait orientation), typed in word processor MSWORD (2003,2007) font TimesNewRoman, KZ Times New Roman (12pt); use single-spaced; paper margins: top2 cm, bottom 2 cm, left 3 cm, right 1.5 cm; text with full justification;

- leave one blank line; title of abstract (bold and capital letters, centered);
- leave one blank line; initials and surname of author, scientific or academic degree;
- new line: name of author's institution or organization and country (in italics, align right);
- leave two blank lines; body of text (in normal type, justified);

• leave one blank line; the reference list (in normal type, centered) follows the text and comprises all the references as they mentioned in the text;

• references in text have to be given by numbers enclosed in square brackets.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject abstracts, which are inappropriate to the conference subjects, do not follow the instructions or are submitted after 3 June 2016.

To be published in the journal "Science Herald of S. Seifullin KATU" articles must be arranged according to instructions, sited in the official website of KATU by reference: http://kazatu.kz/?id=880&lang=ru

The expenses associated with attending the conference are to be covered by participants. The conference participants need to pay organizational fee in the amount of 3000 tenge in order to recompense the organizational expenses including the publication of the proceedings.

### ASTANA is the capital of the Republic of Kazakhstan, one of the youngest capitals in the world
