Requirements for acceptance and preparing abstracts:

• abstracts previously not published anywhere, no more than one abstract from one author are accepted for publication; also one scientific adviser can be co-authored in no more than two theses of doctoral, master and bachelor students.

• a list of references is required, including at least one source included in the Web of Science information base (Thomson Reuters publishing house);

• the abstract, including the list of references, should be no more than 4 (full) A4 pages (portrait orientation), typed in the MSWORD editor (2003,2007) in TimesNewRoman, KZTimesNewRoman (12pt), single spacing, margins: top - 2 cm, bottom - 2 cm, left - 3 cm, right - 1.5 cm, with alignment to the width of the line and the mandatory setting of automatic transfer;

• on the first line in the center - the title of the abstract in capital letters in bold, 1 interval later, to the right - the author's initials and surname, position and academic degree (in italics), 1 interval later - the city and name of the organization or educational institution (in italics), the main text starts at 2 intervals with a red line;

• the list of literature is placed at the end of the text and is drawn up in the order of mentioning of sources, links in the text are made in square brackets.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject abstracts executed in violation of these requirements, not relevant to the conference topics.

To cover organizational and publishing costs, the registration fee is:

1)for young scientists, doctoral, master and bachelor students of KATU and schoolchildren in sole authorship - free of charge; co-authored - 1000 tenge;
