Student safety policy

S. Seifullin Kazakh Agrotechnical University

1. General Provisions

1.1. This Student Safety Policy (hereinafter referred to as the “Policy”) defines the basic principles, measures, and mechanisms for ensuring the safety of students at S. Seifullin Kazakh Agrotechnical University (hereinafter referred to as the “University”).

1.2. The Policy is aimed at creating a safe educational environment, protecting the life and health of students, preventing offenses, emergencies, and other threats.

1.3. The Policy has been developed in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the Charter of the University, and internal regulatory documents.

2. Goals and Objectives of the Policy

2.1. Goals:

- ensuring the physical, psychological, and information security of students;
- fostering a culture of safe behavior;
- preventing emergency situations and minimizing their consequences.

2.2. Objectives:

- organizing a system for the prevention of offenses and injuries;
- ensuring anti-terrorism and fire safety;
- protecting students’ personal data;
- creating conditions for students’ psychological well-being.

3. Main Areas of Safety Assurance

3.1. Physical Safety

- access control to the University territory and buildings;
- operation of video surveillance and security systems;
- compliance with occupational health and safety requirements;
- ensuring safe living conditions in student dormitories.

3.2. Fire and Technogenic Safety

- compliance with fire safety regulations;
- conducting safety briefings and evacuation drills;
- equipping buildings with fire-fighting and alert systems.

3.3. Anti-Terrorism Safety

- implementation of measures to prevent terrorist threats;
- informing students about rules of conduct in case of emergencies;
- cooperation with law enforcement agencies.

3.4. Psychological and Social Safety

- prevention of bullying, discrimination, and violence;
- provision of psychological support to students;
- fostering a tolerant and respectful educational environment.

3.5. Information Security

- protection of students' personal data;
- compliance with rules for using the University's information systems;
- prevention of cyber threats and dissemination of prohibited information.

4. Rights and Responsibilities of Students

4.1. Students have the right to:

- safe learning and living conditions;
- receive information on safety measures;
- seek assistance in case of threats to life, health, or personal dignity.

4.2. Students are obliged to:

- comply with internal regulations and safety requirements;
- follow the lawful instructions of University staff;
- promptly report any identified threats or incidents.

5. Responsibility

5.1. Responsibility for the implementation of this Policy lies with the University management, structural units, and officials within their respective areas of competence.

5.2. Persons who violate safety requirements shall be held liable in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the internal regulations of the University.

6. Final Provisions

6.1. This Policy shall be published on the official website of the University and communicated to students.

6.2. This Policy shall enter into force from the moment of its approval and shall remain effective until a new version is adopted.
