During the period from "November 30" to "18 December" 2015 we took part in a training at the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville (UA).

The main aim of the exchange was an agreement on bilateral cooperation between the University of Arkansas' scientific center for poultry and KATU S.Seifullin.

Further goals were:

- The study of the educational program for undergraduate, graduate and doctoral studies;
- The study of UA's syllabus structure;
- development of a syllabus on the discipline "Poultry product production technology"

During this period we obtained advice on education program with leading lecturers from the «Center of Excellence for Poultry Science» Davon Koltes, PhD, a physiologist; Young Min Kwon, PhD, a microbiologist; Cassey M.Owens, PhD.

There were organized excursions to the research farm for growing broiler chickens and turkeys (plant cultivation, plant incubation, Feed mill, slaughterhouse); the research center «Tyson Foods» (engineer Monica Stewart); to the company «CobbVantress Inc», Andrew Bourne (instructor Asian countries).

We attended seminars on poultry production at Simmons) and a seminar for teachers on the topic "Teaching as Art", organized in honor of the end of the semester.

During the internship we had a fruitful meeting with Michael Kidd, the Director of the Center of Excellence for Poultry Science. The results of the internship will be introduced in two new educational master programs, developed in conjunction with the University of Arkansas for GPIIR, for teaching "Poultry product production technology"
