

On April 17, 2026, a Job Fair was held for graduates of the Institute of Business and Digital Technologies. Students from the following undergraduate programs were invited to the event: "Modern Business Economics," "Business Management and Entrepreneurship," "Accounting, Auditing, and Tax Consulting," "Financial Analytics," "Digital Marketing," "Software Engineering," "Digital Agricultural Systems and Complexes," "Business Informatics," and "Computer Engineering."

Organization managers and representatives presented their institutions, detailing their requirements and working conditions, providing information on average salaries and benefits packages. The event also included individual interviews with employers and a review of graduates' resumes.

Employers also provided information on the number of vacancies and discussed the possibility of concluding contracts with graduates upon completion of their training. Thus, the event provided students with the opportunity to obtain detailed information about the vacancies they were interested in, and potential employers with the opportunity to attract young professionals.
