Submissions will be accepted until 10 September 2022.

Form of conference - online and offline.

The aim of the conference is to publish the scientific results of students and young scientists on topical problems of modern science, exchange ideas and research experience. Development of creative activity of students, undergraduates, doctoral students and scientists, involving them in solving urgent problems.

Conference working languages: **Kazakh, Russian, English**

Abstracts and applications should be submitted according to Annexes 2, 3 to the e-mail addresses of the section secretaries (*e-mail and contact details are given in Annex 1*). **Participants should indicate the format of participation in the conference in their applications.**

The Department of Science is the coordinator of the conference. At the end of the conference, the organising committees (responsible secretaries, after deciding on the acceptance of papers, provide the final abstracts for publication in the collection).

Requirements for the acceptance and formatting of abstracts:

- UDC;
- theses that have not been published elsewhere can only be published with a maximum of one thesis per author;

- a list of references including at least one source from the Scopus and/or Web of Science databases is mandatory;

- theses, including references, should not exceed 4 (full) pages of A4 format (portrait orientation) typed in MSWORD (2003, 2007), Times New Roman font, KZ Times New Roman (12pt) font, single spacing, margins: top - 2 cm, bottom - 2 cm, left - 3 cm, right - 1.5 cm, with alignment to the line width and with automatic hyphenation;

- on the first line, center - title of the thesis in capital letters in bold, 1 spacing after, on the right line - initials and surname of the author, position and academic degree (italics), 1 spacing after - city and name of the organization or educational institution (italics), main text starts 2 spacing on the main line;

- The list of references is placed at the end of the text in the order of the sources cited, with references in square brackets in the text.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not conform to the requirements and do not correspond to the topics of the conference.

To cover organisational and publishing costs, **the registration fee is 3,000 tenge (three thousand tenge).**
